



What is Pornography?

- Derived from the Greek *pornos graphos*, meaning writing about prostitutes.
- In the New Testament Greek *porneia* means sexual immorality associated with whoredom.



What is Pornography?









- 40 million regular users of online pornography in America alone, consuming 1 in 5 of all rentals/pay per view.
- Four billion dollars a year is spent on video pornography in the USA: more than on the major sports

With the advent of the computer, the delivery system for this addictive stimulus [internet pornography] has become nearly resistance free. It is as though we have devised a form of heroin 100 times more powerful than before, usable in the privacy of one's own home and injected directly into the brain through the eyes. It's now available in unlimited supply via a self-replicating distribution network, glorified as art and protected by the constitution.



 Every second there are nearly 30,000 internet users viewing pornography and there are approximately 116,000 online searches for child pornography every day.





- One new porn video is produced every 39 minutes in the USA alone.
- American children begin *hardcore porn* consumption on average at 11 years old
- 4 out of 5 sixteen-year-olds regularly access pornography
- The pornography industry is around a \$97 billion business annually worldwide.
- A 2014 study found that 76% of British men watch internet pornography as do 36% of British women




A **Barna Group** study in 2014 found that approximately 2/3 of self-professed Christian men watch porn monthly (about the same as secular men).

About 15% of Christian women watch it monthly (about half the rate of their secular counterparts).

- The average age of exposure to pornography is between nine and eleven years of age.












Juvenile sex offenders and sex crimes in general have strong links to heavy hardcore porn use.






Addiction to pornography works like a drug remapping the brain.





Dr. Valerie Voon

Studied the phenomena of changes in the brain of heavy users exposed to hardcore pornography and concluded that the brains showed clear and distinct parallels to those with substance addictions.





Change of Attitudes to Pornography

Women being portrayed as objects to be used and abused by men has been remarkably tolerated.







Change of Attitudes to Pornography

A pornographic culture is the *logical development* of a specific worldview that shapes people's understanding of their place in the world.




Marquis de Sade (1740-1814)

In the rituals of fertility cults, chaos is the source of power and regeneration – since all things evolved from the primal chaos.






As Rome deteriorated the circus became increasingly dominant and was closely related to the fertility cult.
